#### From the Principal's desk...

Students began taking their I-Ready Diagnostic Assesments this week, and some will begin next week. Kindergarten and first grade will complete their diagnostic in October. This computer-based assessment will be administered 3 times per year. The results offer insight into each student's unique needs and strengths. The results are delivered immediately since it is online, so teachers can tailor their instruction and support students in real time. It includes local, state, and national norm comparisons, providing context for student performance and growth. Besides reading and math, I-Ready provides critical support of science and social studies learning through its focus on content-area literacy.

Don't forget that this week we will have **Curriculum Night** for the parents: Wednesday, September 3 for K-4 and Thursday, September 4 for 5-8th. Teachers will be explaining their homework policy, curriculum expectations, routines, communication channels, etc. Parents of fifth through eighth graders will rotate through their child's content area classes to visit with each of their child's teachers.

**Grandparents Day:** Grandparents and other special adults will be celebrated on <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 5 from 2 to 3:00</u>. Grandparents will go to the classrooms to be interviewed by their grandchildren and to play games. Families of 3 or more students can choose to go to the gym with their grandparents.
