Our teachers participated in a Professional Learning Day on Monday, September 22. The Middle School teachers attended the **ElevateEd Conference** at Trenton High School, sponsored by NCMC and Northwest Regional Professional Development Center. There were approximately 400 teachers from 20 different school districts attending. Dr. Joe Sanfelippo was the keynote speaker. A nationally recognized leader in education, Dr. Sanfelippo is the former Superintendent of the Fall Creek School District in Wisconsin, where he led transformative work that gained national attention for its innovative approach to school culture, communication, and leadership. The opening session was followed by breakout sessions that teachers could choose from. Teachers of kindergarten through fourth grade had their professional development day learning about Positive Behavior Support Strategies at Bishop Hogan. It was a good day of learning for both groups.

We kicked off our **OASIS Postal Pals** program on Wednesday, September 24. These retired volunteers partner with our **second and third grade students** to exchange letters all year. It gives our students an audience for their writing, and the students love getting letters back from their new friends! We will culminate the program at the end of the year with a reception to celebrate the Postal Pals. We are so appreciative of their time and support of our students!




