Mrs. Chastain’s 2nd grade class discussed why we have leap year & the meaning behind it.



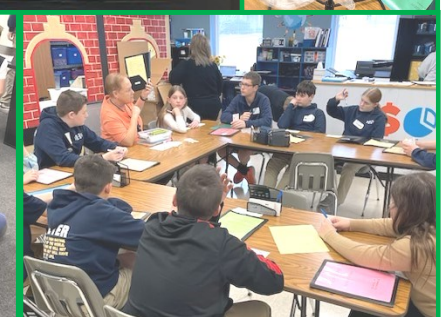
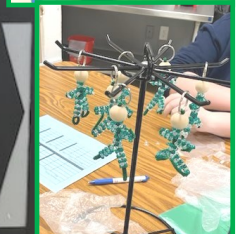
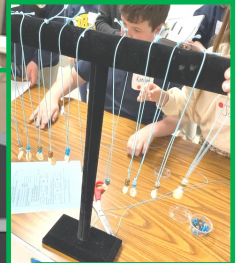
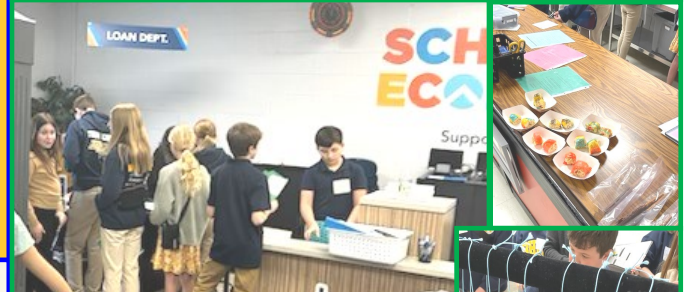
