MoScholars is a state-funded scholarship program designed to support families who enroll their children in private schools, including Bishop Hogan. Eligible to apply are:

- *Students who are entering kindergarten or first grade in our school
- *Siblings of those who were recipients last year
- *Students moving from the public school into any grade at BH
- *Students with an individualized education plan (IEP)

If accepted, this scholarship pays for the school year's tuition, and can be re-granted until a student graduates from 8th grade! It is an amazing opportunity.

We want to extend a big 'thank you' to people who have already promoted the MoScholars by directing half of their MO state income tax liability, taxes they are paying anyway, to education—at no extra cost.
