Mrs. Angela Poling, President of the Chillicothe Rotary Club and program facilitator, shared, "This program truly represents the idea that small actions can create powerful ripples. After seeing the impact during the first year, we are excited to continue this work and further equip these girls with the confidence and tools they need to be leaders and advocates for positive change." The fourth-grade girls meet weekly during lunch with Mrs. Poling. Step Up Graduation will be held on April 9.
