Mrs. Alford's 4th grade class made a grateful turkey to display in their classroom.



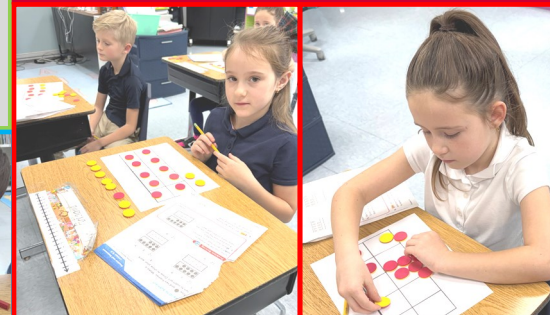
Thank you to everyone that uses the BTC Eagles card. We received a check for \$924.00 in November. We appreciate your support!
