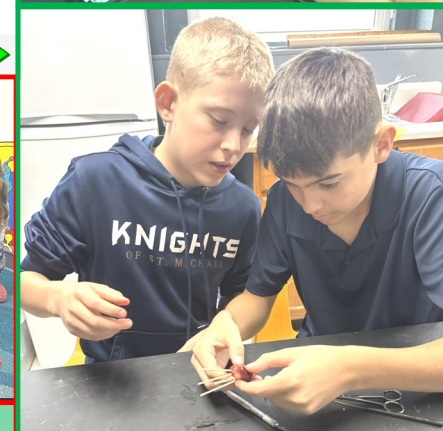
Our students did a wonderful job at their Christmas program! Thank you to everyone who came to support them, and a special thank you to Katharine & Chad for directing the performance.
