The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education awarded Hogan Memorial School a \$50,000 **School Safety Grant for 2024**. We will use the funds for the removal of 4 existing glass entrances and sidelights in the two school buildings and for the replacement with Entry Guard EG3 Resistance glass. We are thrilled to have this financial assistance to upgrade and improve the physical safety of the facilities!

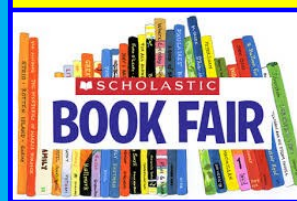
