Thanks to the KidSight organization, our youngest students (preschool, kindergarten and first grade) were provided vision screenings on Wednesday, October 11. Using a photo screening device, trained technicians took a picture of each child's eyes and instantly analyzed the results to determine if the child was at risk for a vision problem. At-risk children are referred to visit an eye doctor, and KidSight staff provide individual, comprehensive, follow-up to connect parents with resources necessary to get their children the care they need.

Our first competitive Middle School basketball games will begin Tuesday, October 17 at home against Grundy County. The girls play at 6 and the boys at 7:00 On Thursday of this past week, our boys' team was divided up for an intersquad scrimmage to help them get ready for the season. All of the boys did a great job! Funds from this event helped support the March for Life 8th grade trip.

Father Koster gave each of the classes two names of Seminarians to partner with. They attend Kenrick-Glennon Seminary, Conception Seminary College, Mount St. Mary;s Seminary, or St. Gregory the Great Seminary. Our students will write letters to these young men, encouraging them, asking them questions, and telling them they are praying for them. This was done last year with Seminarians and was a great success. We even had one of the Seminarians visit our school to talk to all the classes, spending the most time with his partner class! What an awesome way to give support to the Seminarians in their guest to answer God's call and fulfill His plan for them. And who knows, it may lead to some of our students studying for the priesthood some day!



Ms. Ginger's 2nd grade religion class had fun creating a paper quilt. Each of them decorated their own square and then pieced it together to create their guilt.




