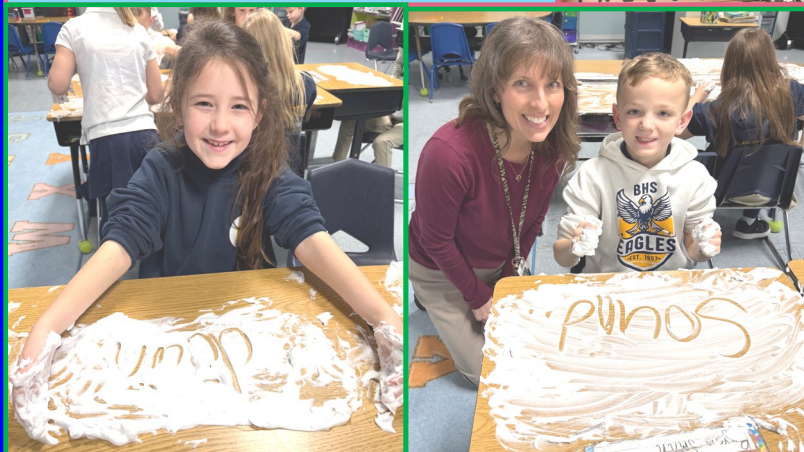
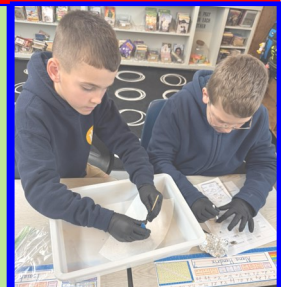
We are off to a great start!!
