Thank you to all those who buy gift cards from Bishop Hogan School! The **SOAR Gift Card Program** (School Opportunities & Academic Resources) has purchased numerous items for our school/students and has helped families with tuition credit. **Here's how it works:**

*We purchase gift cards at a discounted price that can be used at dozens of local businesses and many more nationwide. The cards are sold at face value, resulting in a profit for the school without costing you anything additional. You get to spend the full face value of the cards. The profit realized by the school comes from the merchants whose cards you purchase, anywhere from 1.5%-20%.

*SOAR gift cards can be ordered in one of 3 ways—download the **RaiseRight app**, go online at raiserright.com or use the **Paper Order form** (available at school or in the gift card box at church). Cards ordered by 10 am on Monday will be available to pick up the following Friday. There are over 750 participating businesses nationwide. Many gift cards are kept on hand at the school or in the back of the church for purchase.

*Your options include **eGift cards, physical gift cards** that can be picked up or shipped to your home using the Ship to Home option, or **reloadable gift cards**.

The enrollment code if you go online is **6486653L3529L**. This will **tie** your earnings to Bishop Hogan School or a particular student's tuition here. We hope you'll take advantage of this great program! Let us know if you have any questions!

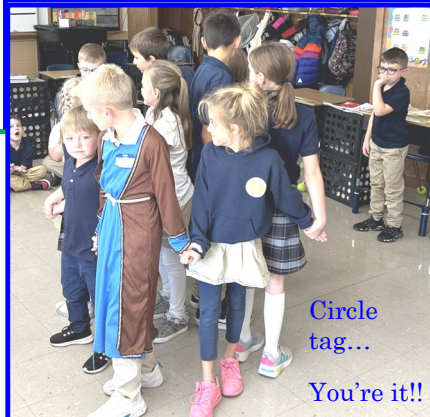
